Topics include water rescue skills, surveillance and recognition, first aid, breathing and cardiac emergencies, CPR, AED and more. This program reflects the latest ECC science and findings from the 2011 United States Lifeguard Standards Coalition Report. Participants must be able to pass a pre-course swim evaluation and attend every scheduled session to become certified. Participants must be at least 15 years of age by the first of class.
