The symbol *** means that a homeowner may install the plant, but the **VGHOA** will not be responsible of the plant.

The homeowner is also responsible for the eventual replacement of the street trees located in the right of way (area between the sidewalk and curb). When replacing a street tree a Biobarrier is required between the sidewalk and the street tree and curb and the street tree.
