

Local Rules: Updated (January 2019)

- 1. If a ball lies in a tire track anywhere through the green the ball may be lifted, without penalty, and dropped within one club length from the nearest point of relief no closer to the hole.
- 2. If a ball lies in a washout area anywhere through the green the ball may be lifted, without penalty, and dropped within one club length from the nearest point of relief no closer to the hole.
- 3. If a ball lies in a washout area in a sand bunker the ball may be lifted, without penalty, and dropped at the nearest point of relief within the sand bunker but no closer to the hole.
- 4. If a ball lies in standing water in a sand bunker the ball may be lifted and dropped at the nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole. If a point no closer to the hole cannot be attained, then relief may be taken anywhere within the sand bunker. If there is no point within the sand bunker where relief can be taken the ball may then be lifted and dropped outside the bunker, without penalty, on a line from the hole through where the ball was at rest.
- 6. Any hole where the club has deemed Cart Path Only: Lift, clean and place (marking your ball and placing back to its original position) in your own fairway.
- 7. The 'new' Stroke and Distance local rule will be in effect for daily play as well as competitive events. See the Rules of Golf for description of the new relief.
