

OPCC POOL REOPENING GUIDELINES

Orange Park Country Club Residents, **YOU ARE THE KEY COMPONENT** in our ability to reopen the pool amenity. We have prepared the following operating guidelines to ensure the safety of our residents. It is imperative that you comply. The pool and cabana are monitored via video surveillance 24/7. There will be zero tolerance for policy breaking.

Before coming to the pool please ask yourself the following questions:

1. Do you have any of the following: fever, shortness of breath, cough, sore throat, muscle pain, chills, headache, new loss of taste or smell?
2. Are you ill or caring for someone who is ill?
3. Have you had contact with anyone that was diagnosed with Covid-19 in the last 14 days?

If you answer yes to any of the above, please do not come to the pool amenity.

Hours of Operation: May – October 6 am – 9 pm and November – April 8 am – 5 pm

Guests are not permitted at this time due to limited capacity. If capacity or usage changes, this policy will be adjusted.

During Phase 1 pools are limited to 50% capacity.

Wading pool is restricted to 5 individuals

Large pool is restricted to 30 individuals

New pool is restricted to 16 individuals

Due to the restrictions on capacity, please limit your time at the pool so that your friends and neighbors can also enjoy the pool.

COVID-19 WARNING

- The danger of exposure to the coronavirus that causes COVID-19 exists.
- By entering the pool and cabana, you take responsibility for you own protection and for disinfecting your hands and anything you touch in the pool area. You must bring your own sanitizers and wipes.
- Wash or disinfect hands before and after swimming. Please use proper hygiene and cleaning techniques at all times.
- Maintain at least 6 feet between you and other people who are not part of your household in and out of the pool.
- Group games are prohibited.
- It is recommended, but not required that masks be worn when outside of the pool.

Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

Uses of tables, chairs and chaises

Furniture may not be moved. Residents are required to bring and use a towel when using chairs or chaises and are responsible for the cleanliness of the chair, table or chaise. **You must bring your own cleaning solution and sanitize prior to leaving.**

Coolers and Food will not be allowed. Use of the grills will not be allowed. Please bring your own water bottles as the water fountains will be unavailable at this time.

There will be no group gatherings or organized events, such as birthday parties or neighborhood socials permitted in the cabana at this time.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES MAY RESULT IN YOUR POOL FOB BEING DEACTIVATED OR POOL CLOSURE!
